keynote address on the theme was also delivered by Dr. Balkar Singh FIE, Former Joint Director, Punjab Energy Development Agency, Chandigarh.

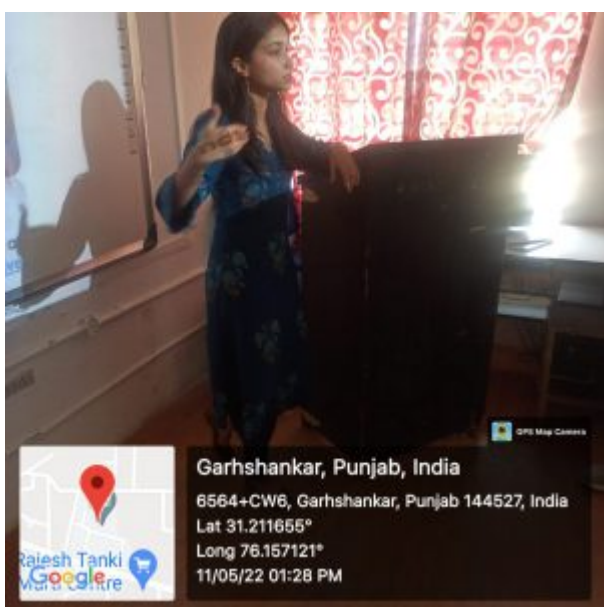

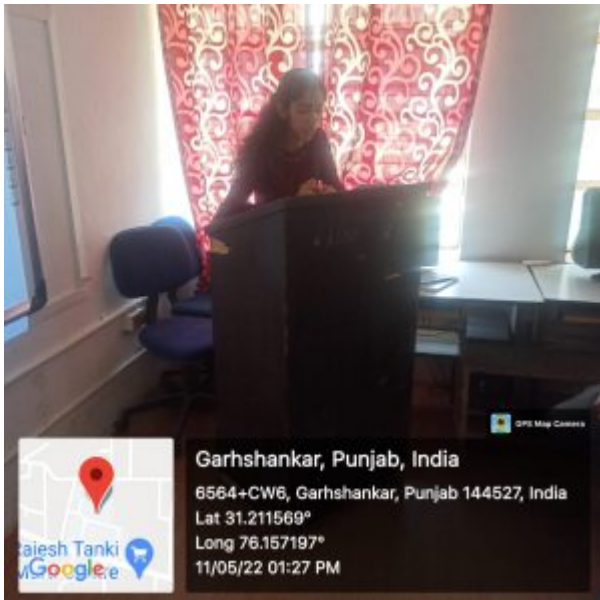

The workshop was to create awareness about the new ICT tools, including sessions Logo editing,Poster Design, Certificate

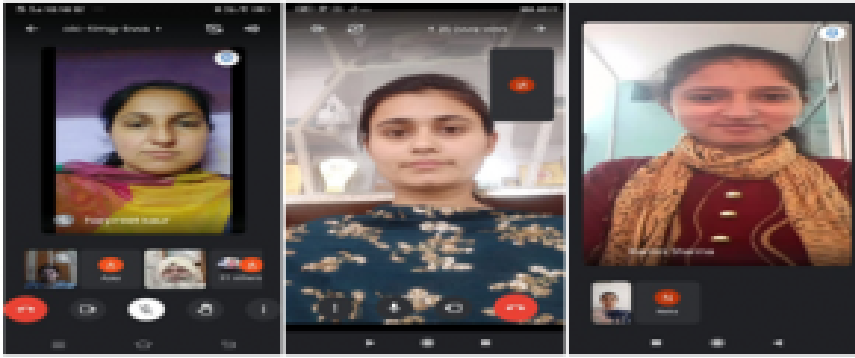
