

International Seminar Organized by Arts Department (Liberal Arts Society)

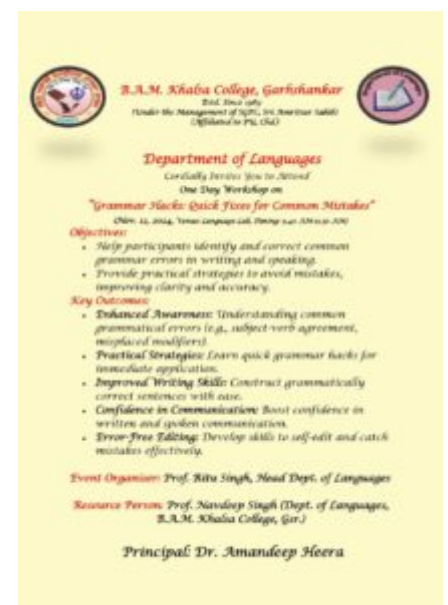
