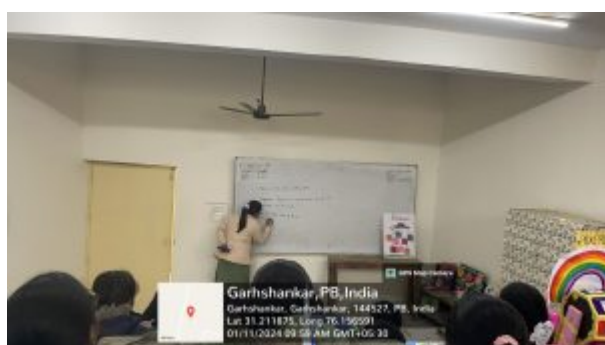


Skill-In-Teaching and Best Teaching Aid Competition



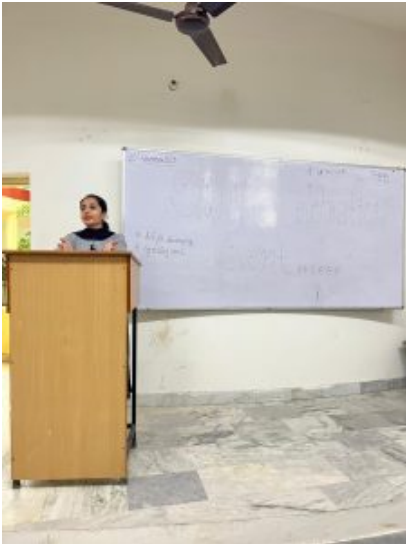
