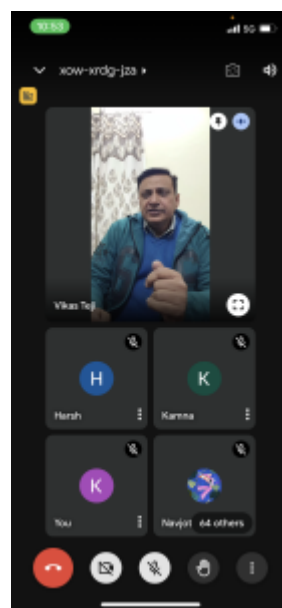
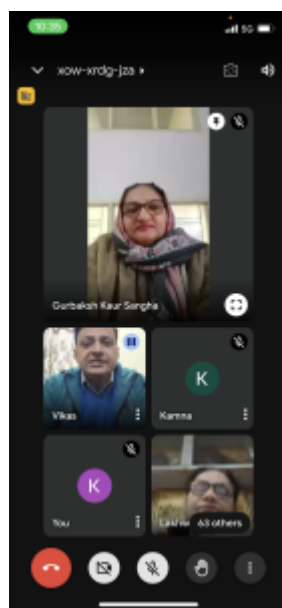
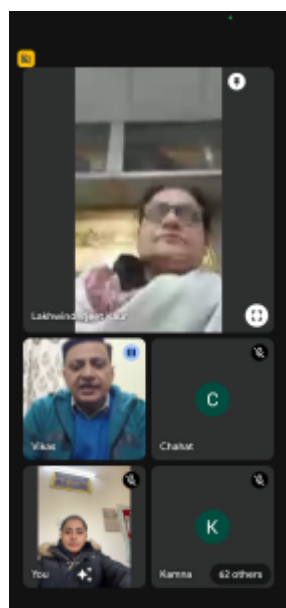
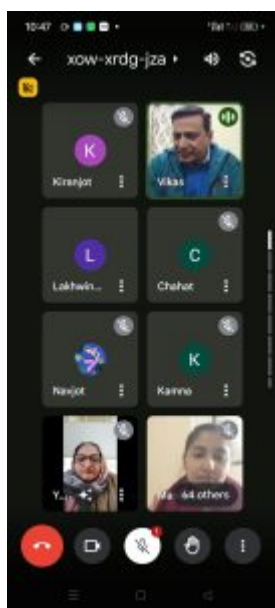
PowerPoint Presentation on National Science Day
