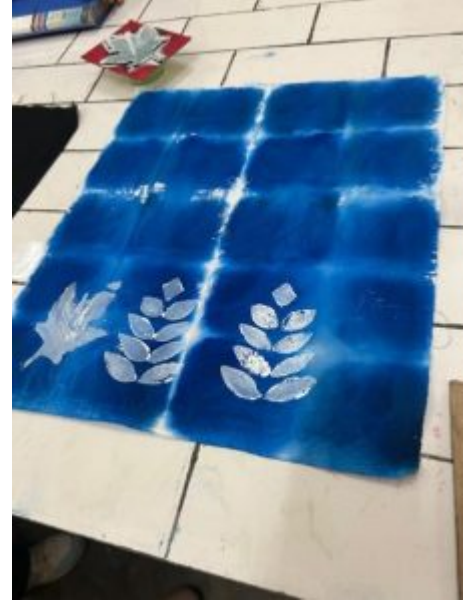
CHANDRAYAAN-3 POSTER PRESENTATION ON AUGUST 19, 2023

Workshop on Fabric Painting 24/04/2024

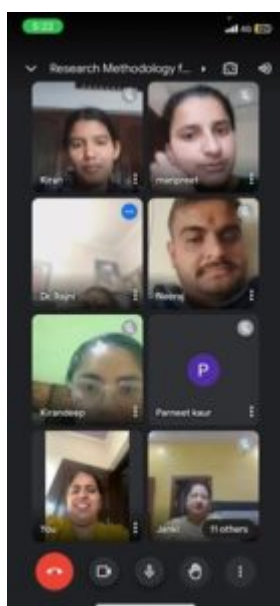
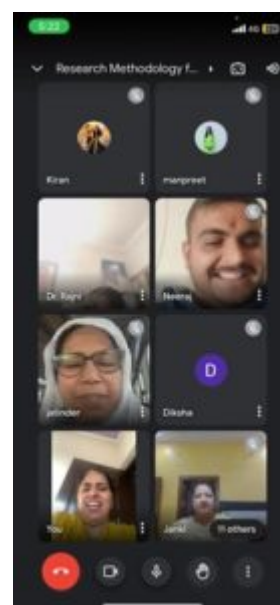
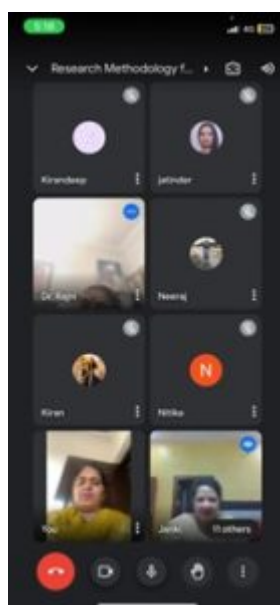
